

Obstetric Comorbidity Index (OCI) Score Communication Tool

While managed care plans (MCPs) may utilize claims data to complete OCI scoring for pregnant members, the OCI can also be used clinically. This form may be used by MCPs to inform OCI implementation or by care teams to risk assess Medi-Cal members and report back scores to the MCP.
